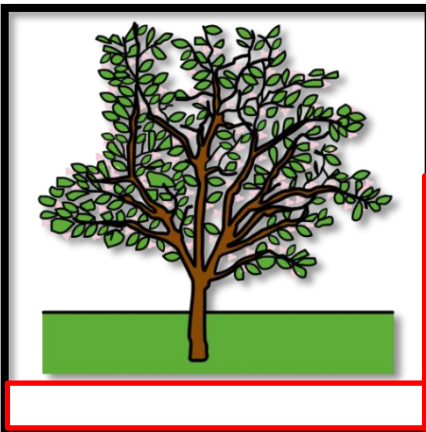
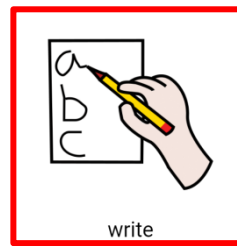
Some trees lose their leaves in autumn and winter. They are deciduous

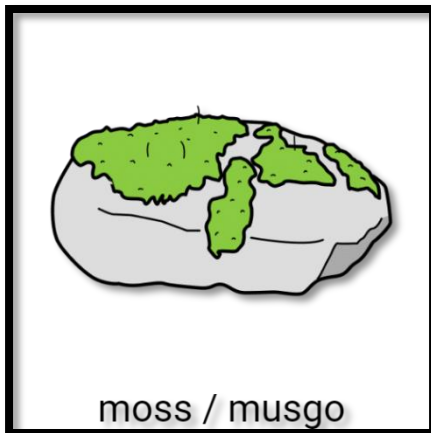

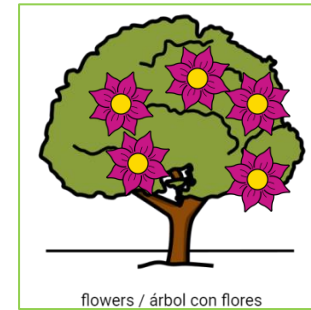


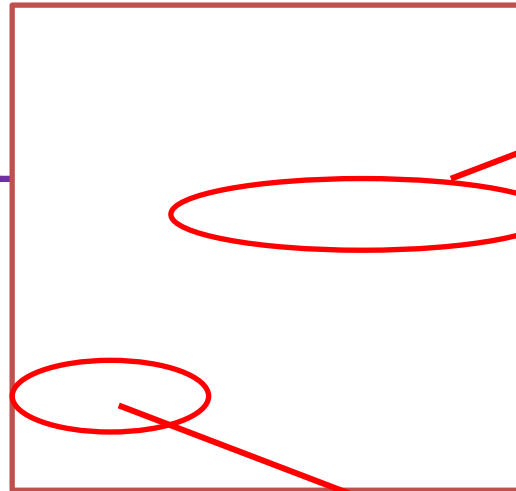
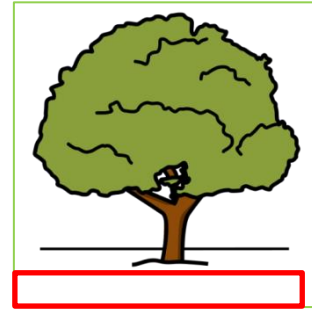
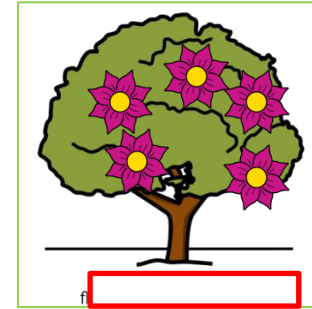
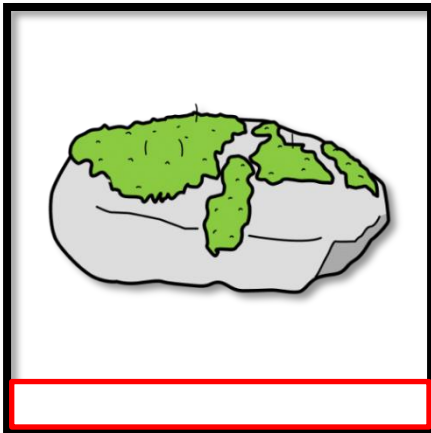


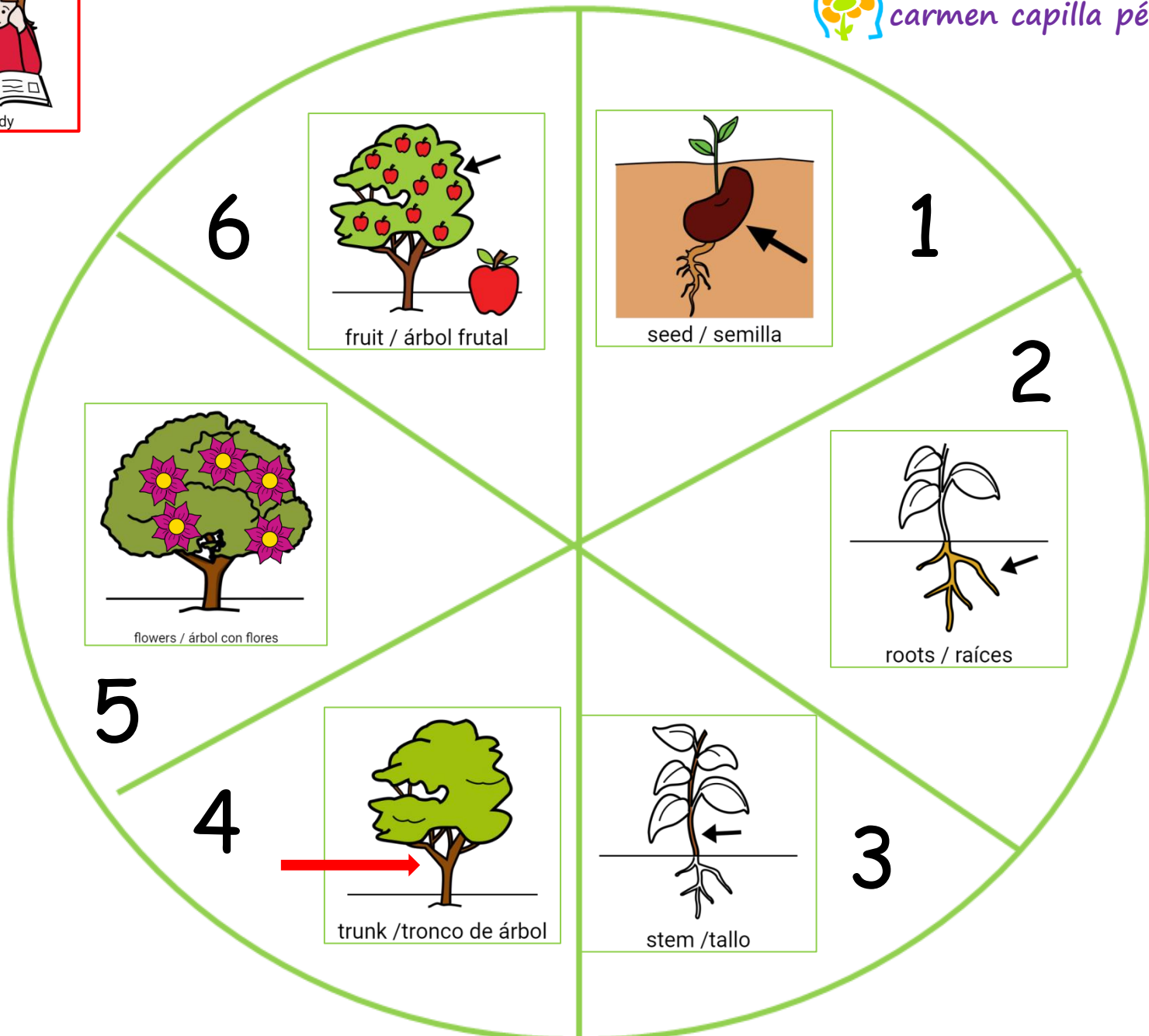
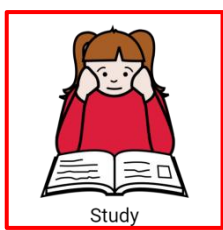




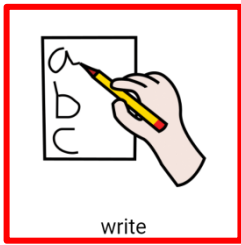
Some plants do not produce flowers or seeds. They are called **non-flowering** plants. Some non-flowering plants use **spores** to reproduce



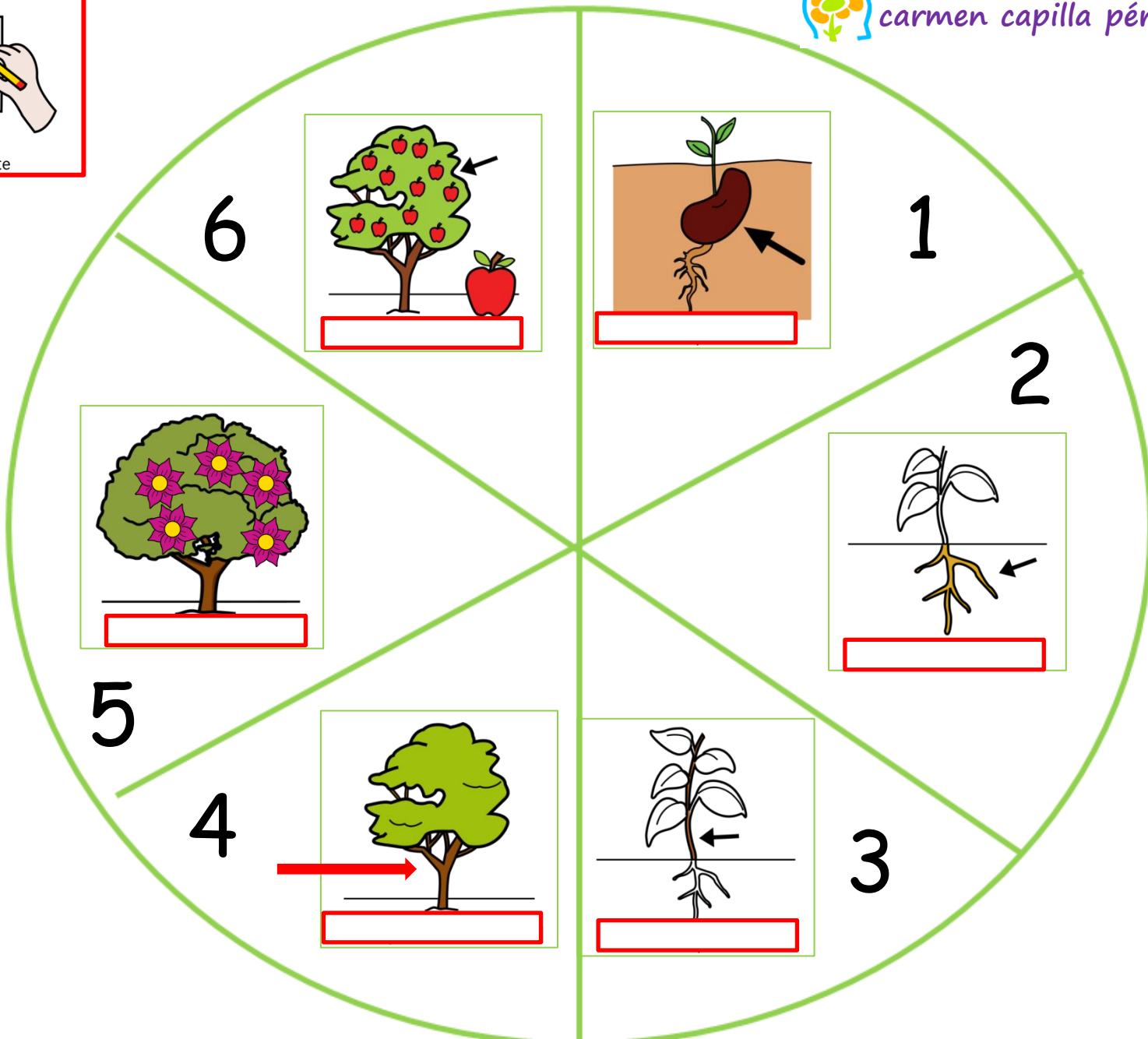




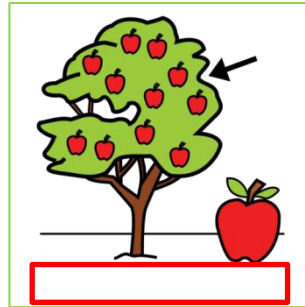




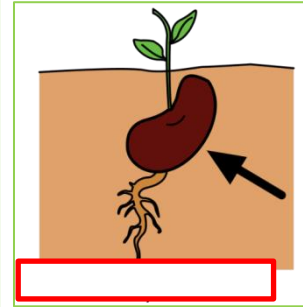
